Fathers – Be All That You Can Be! We Need You!

During the winter of 1993, construction workers at the Baseball Hall of Fame in Cooperstown, New York, made a heartwarming discovery. While remodeling a section of the museum, they found a photograph that someone had stuck in a crevice underneath a display case. The man smiling in the picture had a bat resting on his shoulders; he was wearing a baseball uniform with the words Sinclair Oil emblazoned across the chest. Stapled to the picture was a note, scribbled in pen: *“You were never too tired to play ball. On your days off, you helped build the Little League Field. You always came to watch me play. You were a Hall of Fame Dad. I wish I could share this moment with you. Your Son, Peter”*. A son named Peter had managed to find a way to put his dad in baseball’s Hall of Fame.

Within our families, we experience the heights of joy and the depths of pain. The memories we treasure, the values we learn in our families are the most important and lasting lessons we will ever learn. Our belonging to a family means that each one of us, parent and child, reflects for one another, the selfless, limitless and unconditional love of Christ, both in good times and bad times.

Believe it or not, studies show that the father has more influence with his children when it comes to transmitting religious values than Catholic Schools, Religious Education Programs, and believe it or not, mothers. Thank you fathers, living and dead, for all that you have done and are doing for us.

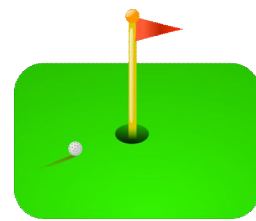
ST. SEBASTIAN'S TERRACE AND COLUMBARIUM

For those of you not familiar with a Columbarium, it is a Latin word that describes a collection of niches to house urns containing cremated human remains. Usually inscribed with the person's name and dates of birth and death, columbaria are constructed to serve as permanent resting places for our loved ones in a 'churchyard' or landscaped terrace. May the Lord who has blessed this project now be a final resting place for many of our loved ones.

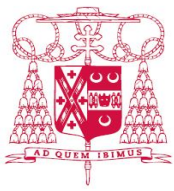

Types of Skin Cancer

The most common form of skin cancer is **Basal Cell Carcinoma**. Basal cell carcinoma is primarily caused by chronic exposure to sunlight, and it most frequently occurs on exposed parts of the body-the face, neck, ears, scalp, shoulders and back.

Although anyone can get basal cell carcinoma, those with light hair, fair skin, and blue or green eyes are at the highest risk, as well as those who have occupations that require long hours outdoors. Basal cell carcinoma frequently looks like an open sore and usually remains open for three or more weeks. It may also resemble a reddish patch of dry skin that crusts, a shiny bump, a pink growth with elevated borders, or a scar where the skin actually appears lighter in color.

Squamous cell carcinoma is the second most common type of skin cancer. Although squamous cell can appear on any part of the body, it more commonly appears on areas exposed to the sun. It may also occur where skin has suffered certain injuries such as burns, scars, or long-standing sores. Chronic sun exposure is also the culprit behind this type of skin cancer.

Those with fair skin are again most at risk for developing this disease. However, more than 2/3 of the skin cancers in individuals with African descent are squamous cell carcinomas arising out of sites of preexisting inflammatory skin conditions or burn injuries. Squamous cell carcinoma may resemble a wart-like growth that crusts and occasionally bleeds, a persistent scaly red patch with irregular borders that sometimes crusts and bleeds, an open sore that bleeds, crusts and persists for weeks, or an elevated growth with a central depression that occasionally bleeds.

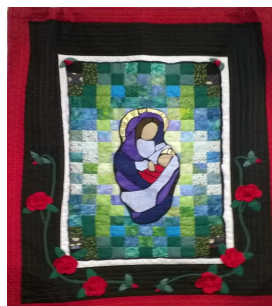
