***From the Desk of Fr. Szymon Kurpios***

***August 21, 2016***

Today, the Gospel raises the theme of the salvation for our souls. This is the essence of Christ's message and the "supreme law of the Church" (in fact, this is also mentioned in the Code of Canon Law). The salvation of our soul is an actual fact insofar a gift from God, but for those of us that have not yet crossed the threshold of death, is only a possibility. To be saved or to be damned to hell! That is, to accept or to reject God's everlasting offer of love.

St. Augustine said "the man who self-annihilated his goodness, which could have been eternal, deserved the eternal damnation". We have only two possibilities in our life: either God or the void. For without God nothing has any meaning. In this sense, when we do not participate of the essence of God, life, death, joy, pain, love, etc., are just concepts without any logic. When we sin, we avoid the Creator's glance to center it upon him. God is constantly looking at the sinner with love and in order not to force his freedom; he expects a minimum gesture of the sinner to be willing to get back to him.

"Lord, is it true that few people will be saved"? (Lk.13:23). Christ does not respond to this question. Therefore, it remained unanswered, just as it is today, for it is an inscrutable mystery between the saintliness of God and the conscience of man. "The silence of the Church is, therefore, Christians' only opportune position". (Saint John Paul II). The Church does not state any opinion about those who dwell in hell but, basing itself in Christ's words, it does state an opinion about its existence and the fact there will be many damned in the Final Judgment. And whoever denies this, whether clerical or lay, incurs, without further ado, in heresy.

We are free to turn the stare of our soul towards the Savior, and we are also free to stick to our refusal. Our death will simply petrify our option forever.

### **Readings for this Week, 21st Sunday in Ordinary Time**

**First Reading: Isaiah 66:18-21** - Isaiah portrays a time when people from many nations will gather in Jerusalem and proclaim God's glory. God's messengers will teach many nations about God. Just as the Israelites bring offerings; these messengers will bring people from all nations to worship.

**Second Reading: Hebrews 12:5-7, 11-13** - The Hebrews are told that God disciplines those he loves. When a parent disciplines a child, the child usually learns what is expected of him. The Hebrews are encouraged to face life's trials as a form of discipline, and attempt to learn something from them.

**Gospel: Luke 13:22-30** - Jesus warns that the door to God's kingdom will be locked for those who ignored his wishes. Many people will come from all nations and take their place in God's kingdom. Others will not be recognized by God, and he will reject them.

For those of you not familiar with a Columbarium, it is a Latin word that describes a collection of niches to house urns containing cremated human remains. May the Lord who has blessed this project now be a final resting place for many of our loved ones.

## From the Parish Nurse

### Back to School - Pinworm

Pinworm is an infection caused by a small, white intestinal worm. Pinworms are about the length of a staple and live in the rectum of humans. While the infected person sleeps, female pinworms leave the intestines through the anus and deposit eggs on the surrounding skin.

Pinworms are most common in school-age children and pre-schoolers. Infection usually occurs in more than one family member, but adults are less likely to be infected.

Symptoms include itching, disturbed sleep, and irritability. If infection is heavy, loss of appetite, restlessness and difficulty sleeping may occur. The symptoms are caused by the female pinworm laying her eggs.

Pinworms eggs are infective within a few hours of being deposited on the skin. They can survive for up to two weeks on clothes, bedding, or other objects. One can become infected after accidentally ingesting infective pinworm eggs from contaminated surfaces or fingers.

#### Treatment includes:

Either prescription or over the counter drugs: You should consult your health care provider before treating a suspected case of pinworm. Treatment involves a two-dose course. The second dose should be given two weeks after the first.

#### To prevent re-infection:

- \*Bathe your child when he/she wakes up to reduce the egg contamination
- \*Change and wash underwear every day
- \*Change underwear, nightclothes, and sheets after each treatment
- \*Because eggs are sensitive to sunlight, keep shades open during the day
- \*Excellent personal hygiene-washing hands after toileting, before eating and after changing diapers is extremely important
- \*Keep fingernails short
- \*Discourage nail biting and scratching of infected areas

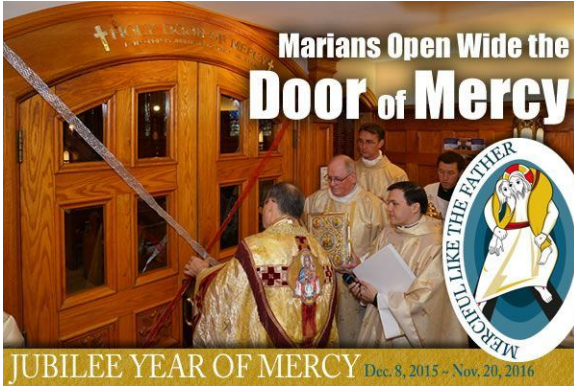

# Saint James Parish Pilgrimage to the Shrine of Divine Mercy

Saturday, October 15, 2016



Pope Francis inaugurated the extraordinary Jubilee Year of Mercy on Dec. 8, urging the faithful to come to know the face of God's mercy — Jesus Christ — and to show that face of mercy to our friends, neighbors, and enemies alike.

"This extraordinary Holy Year is itself a gift of grace," Pope Francis said in his homily for the Jubilee's opening Mass, just before opening the Holy Door in St. Peter's Basilica. Only hours later, the Marian Fathers in Stockbridge, Massachusetts, opened a newly installed Holy Door of their own at the inside entrance to the National Shrine of The Divine Mercy. Indeed,

at the request of Pope Francis, for the first time in the 700-year-old tradition of Jubilee years, dioceses around the world opened their own Holy Doors at specific pilgrimage locations.

The Shrine in Stockbridge was selected by the Most Rev. Mitchell T. Rozanski, the bishop of the Diocese of Springfield, Massachusetts, to be among the dioceses official Jubilee Year destinations.
