Tomorrow is Halloween, my sister's favorite holiday. In the present day, this is a day of candy, costumes and sometimes pranks. This is enjoyable but we forget that this is also a day when our focus turns to those who have gone before us. Halloween is followed by **All Saints Day, a Holy Day of Obligation**, and the next day is **All Souls Day**. On these two days we remember and celebrate the lives of those who have gone before us.

The feast of **All Saints** gives thanks to God for all those who have experienced the resurrection and rest now in the peace of Christ. When we die and return to our Father we are not angels but rather saints. We remember all of these souls every time we say the Creed and re-state our belief in the Communion of Saints.

The feast of **All Souls** commemorates those who have gone before us and await their admission into the Communion of Saints. We are called to remember their lives and their faith. We give thanks to them for the faith that they have passed on to us, their descendants, and pray for that time when we will join them in the Heavenly Banquet.

For those of you not familiar with a Columbarium, it is a Latin word that describes a collection of niches to house urns containing cremated human remains. Usually inscribed with the person's name and dates of birth and death, columbaria are constructed to serve as permanent resting places for our loved ones in a 'churchyard' or landscaped terrace. We pray that the Lord who has blessed this project, become a final resting place for many of our loved ones.

## From the Parish Nurse



### Breast Cancer Treatment

Treatment for breast cancer varies considerably depending upon the type of tumor, size, and grade of the tumor as well as other variables. Some of the standard treatments include:

#### Surgery

Lumpectomy removes the tumor and some of the surrounding tissue leaving the breast intact.

Mastectomy removes the entire affected breast.

Sentinel node biopsy-removal of one specific lymph node, known as the sentinel node. A sentinel node biopsy will provide specific information which will determine further treatment options.

Auxiliary lymph node dissection-removal of all the lymph nodes on the affected side. This is performed in conjunction with a mastectomy.

Radiation-targets the diseased breast tissue. This is often performed in conjunction with surgery.

Chemotherapy-This is also often part of a treatment plan including surgery.

Hormone therapy-Specific therapy used to block hormone release. This is useful in cancers that proliferate in the presence of estrogen or progesterone.

Targeted drug therapy- attacks specific abnormalities within the cancer cells.
