For those of you not familiar with a Columbarium, it is a Latin word that describes a collection of niches to house urns containing cremated human remains. Usually inscribed with the person's name and dates of birth and death, columbaria are constructed to serve as permanent resting places for our loved ones in a 'churchyard' or landscaped terrace. We pray that the Lord who has blessed this project, become a final resting place for many of our loved ones.

Alzheimer's Disease

Alzheimer's disease is a progressive disease of the brain which causes memory and intellectual loss serious enough to interfere with and affect daily life. It is the most common form of dementia, accounting for 60-80% of all dementias, but it is **not** a **normal** part of aging.

Some facts and figures:

- More than 5 million Americans are currently living with the disease.
- Every 67 seconds someone in the United States develops Alzheimer's.
- Alzheimer's is the 6th leading cause of death in the United States.
- Approximately 500,000 people die each year from Alzheimer's.
- 1 in 3 senior citizens dies with Alzheimer's or another form of dementia.
- In 2013, 15.5 million caregivers provided an estimated 17.7 billion hours of unpaid care valued at more than \$220 billion.

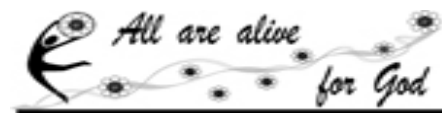

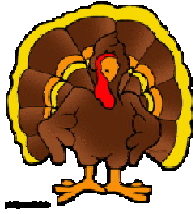
My name is Eden Barone and I am twelve years old turning thirteen in December. I live with my mom and dad, and my brothers, Ralph and Marcus. I love to play softball and piano. I go to George Fischer Middle School. I enjoy learning about history in school. My biggest accomplishment was becoming a black belt in Tae Kwon Do. I've been going there with my brothers and dad for the last nine years.

Being Catholic is important to me because I love God and his beliefs. My mom and dad set a good example for me being a good Catholic because they taught me everything I know about Catholic faith. My dad travels around the world for work meeting clients; my mom stays at home and takes care of the family. They taught me how to behave in church. They also show me love and care towards one another and how to pray to God every night.

Although I've been practicing as a Catholic from when I was four, there are a few questions still unanswered. Like, what is life after death? How much of a commitment does it take for being a priest when receiving the sacrament of Holy Orders?
