***BE ALL THAT YOU CAN BE- GO TO CHURCH! SMILE!
WHY GO TO CHURCH?***

A churchgoer wrote a letter to the editor of a newspaper and complained that it made no sense to go to church every Sunday. "I've gone for 30 years now" he wrote, "and in that time I have heard something like 3,000 sermons. But for the life of me, I can't remember a single one of them. So I think I'm wasting my time and the pastors are wasting theirs by giving sermons at all.

This started a real controversy in the "Letters to the Editor" column, much to the delight of the editor. It went on for weeks until someone wrote this clincher:

I've been married for 30 years now. In that time my wife had cooked some 32,000 meals. But for the life of me I cannot recall the entire menu for a single one of those meals. But I do know this; they all nourished me and gave me the strength I needed to do my work. If my wife had not given me these meals, I would be physically dead today. Likewise, if I had not gone to church for nourishment, I would be spiritually dead today.

When you are DOWN to nothing God is UP to something! Faith sees the invisible, believes the incredible, and receives the impossible! Thank God for our physical AND spiritual nourishment.

Try solving this riddle:

What gift enriches the receiver without diminishing the giver?

What gift can be given in a flash, but can have an impact that lasts forever?

What gift is of no earthly value until it is given away?

What gift is such that no one is so poor that he or she cannot share it, and no one is so rich that he or she doesn't have a need for the gift.

The answer? A smile! Like smiles, our gifts to others never leave us impoverished. God always makes sure that we get back more than we have given. How generous are we towards those in need? What I keep, I lose; what I give away is mine forever.

TWENTY-EIGHTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

First Reading: Wisdom 7:7-11

This poem discusses how the spirit of wisdom is far more beautiful than any riches could be. All gold is no more than sand when compared to the importance of wisdom.

Second Reading: Hebrews 4:12-13

God's perception of people is called "sharper than any two-edged sword." God is able to know the thoughts and feelings of all his people. We can hide nothing from him, and will need to account for all he has seen in us.

Gospel: Mark 10:17-30

A man asks Jesus how he can share in everlasting life. Jesus tells him to sell his possessions and travel with them. The man refuses and Jesus tells his disciples how difficult it is for a rich person to enter heaven if they are too concerned with their possessions. The disciples remind Jesus that they gave up everything for him, but he assures them they will be rewarded with everlasting life.

Our Terrace and Columbarium are open. We have already celebrated Mass at the new Altar and have 86 niches engraved and interred. The price of a niche is \$2,500, which gives you the right to inter the remains of two people. If you have been thinking of purchasing a niche, please contact Mrs. Maureen Larkin at 845-225-2079 ext.105 Monday to Wednesday for information and an appointment. For those of you not familiar with a Columbarium, it is a Latin word that describes a collection of niches to house urns containing cremated human remains. Usually inscribed with the person's name and dates of birth and death, columbaria are constructed to serve as permanent resting places for our loved ones in a 'churchyard' or landscaped terrace. May the Lord who has blessed this project now be a final resting place for many of our loved ones.

Autism (ASD) Diagnosis

Diagnosis of Autism or Autism Spectrum Disorder is often a two-stage process. The first part is a general screening performed during well-child visits with a pediatrician. Children who show some developmental problems at this stage might be referred for additional evaluation. The second screening will be a more thorough evaluation by a team of doctors and other health professionals from a wide variety of specialties. These will include a neurologist, psychologist, speech therapist, and psychiatrist. Parents will be asked about their child's symptoms and special testing instruments will be used to attain information that will be useful in diagnosis. These include:

- Checklist of Autism for Toddlers (CHAT)
- Modifies Checklist for Autism in Toddlers (M-CHAT)
- Screening Tool or Autism in Two –Year-Olds (STAT)
- Social Communication Questionnaire (SCQ)
- Communication and Symbolic Behavior Scales (CSBS)

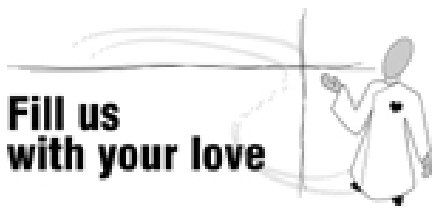
For older children the following screening tools may be used:

- Autism Spectrum Screening Questionnaire (ASSQ)
- Australian Scale for Asperger's Syndrome (ASAS)
- Childhood Asperger Syndrome Test (CAST)

The second stage of the testing must be thorough in order to rule out any other conditions which might be causing your child's symptoms.

Free Pegasus Program for Families in Need
